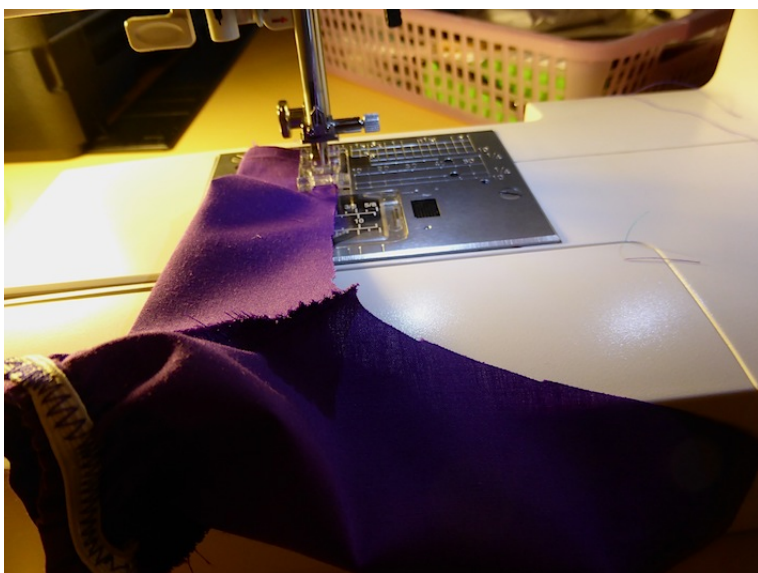


TROUSERS/SLACKS FOR BARBIE-STYLE DOLLS

1. All seams 3mm. It is a good idea to zig zag the raw edges, to prevent fraying.
2. Cut 2 legs using selvages for the bottom of the legs to give a neat finish.
3. Join centre front rises (new word: the distance between waist and crotch) of each leg (same back and front so it doesn't really matter which side you use.)
4. Turn over the top waist edge twice to avoid raw edges and press
5. Cut 5 mm (1/4 inch) elastic to the exact size of the waist of the doll, about 9 cms
6. Zig zag the elastic to the waist just below the edge (this is much easier than sewing the elastic on after you have joined the legs together) stretching the elastic as you go-this can be difficult so pull the fabric from behind to make sure the thread doesn't get stuck in the one place.
7. Join centre backs together.
8. Fold legs to the middle and sew around inside leg seams.
9. You can make the rise shorter if you prefer and vary the length of legs too
